Methods of payment

EUROPE

European banks has developed a system of international Bank Account Number (IBAN) which is a standardised method to interpret and control bank account numbers applied to international payments within Europe.

We need the following bank information from you in order to settle an invoice:

- Account holder
- Bank and branch name
- Bank address (street, postal code, country)
- Bank account number/IBAN
- SWIFT/BIC code

Make sure you address the invoice correctly, see postal address in letterhead!

USA

While IBAN in Europe is in place almost everywhere, it is not yet implemented in the US. For transactions in America we therefore need ABA codes or routing numbers.

We need the following bank information from you in order to settle an invoice:

- Account holder
- Bank and branch name
- Bank address (street, postal code, country)
- Bank account number
- Routing number/ABA code
- SWIFT code (if your bank does not have a SWIFT code, let us know the name and address of the bank)

Make sure you address the invoice correctly, see postal address in letterhead!
